

Job Vacancy Church Worker – Children & Families

Brackla Tabernacle is looking to recruit a Church Worker – Children & Families. The successful applicant will have the necessary skills to be responsible for the leadership and development of our children's ministries (primary years) and the discipling and equipping of families. This is a fixed term role for 24 months and we are looking for the individual to join the staff team from January 2023, or sooner.

About Brackla Tabernacle

Brackla Tabernacle is committed to be a place, community and family 'where God is known.' We are a Church family from and for Bridgend County, seeking to impact the entire County with the transformative message of Jesus Christ. Brackla Tabernacle is deeply committed to engaging with people who do not know the saving power of Jesus Christ and want to make every area of our Church family accessible. We exist to make Jesus known and knowable, for those who are yet to be a part of our Church family and so that this Church flourishes. The Church meets at Archbishop McGrath High School on Sunday mornings and utilises our Church Building and various small groups throughout the week. We are part of the Apostolic Church UK.

About the role

The successful applicant will lead and develop all areas of the children and families provision within Brackla Tabernacle: recruiting and equipping a team of volunteers, running activity programmes, delivering age appropriate teaching, supporting families and ensuring that all activities and personnel adhere to our safeguarding policy. The position forms part of the staff team at Brackla Tabernacle, which serves the wider Church family on a day-to-day basis. The role is a 20-30 hour per week provision with hours negotiated on interview – precise routine of hours worked can be flexible to meet the service needs, but will include Sunday morning provision, potential afterschool activities and the development of family programmes. Potential ad hoc seasonal events may require the individual to work outside of normal hours.

Applicants will need to demonstrate commitment to the Christian faith and an understanding of our vision and ethos.

The Church Worker – Children & Families will report directly to the Lead Pastor.

Please note – Due to the need to personally model the church's ethos and values, lead worship services, pray with others and serve in pastoral situations, there is a genuine occupational requirement for the post holder to be a committed evangelical Christian.

To provide vision, oversight and leadership in developing the children & families provision of Brackla Tabernacle. To equip and energise the whole church for mission to our younger generations and families.
